New National Minimum Wage rates announced

The Department for Trade and Industry has announced the rates of the National Minimum Wage to apply from 1 October 2007. The revised rates will be as follows:

- for workers aged 22 and over, the rate will rise from the current £5.35 per hour to £5.52;
- for workers aged 18-21 it will rise from £4.45 to £4.60; and
- for workers aged 16 and 17 it will rise from £3.30 to £3.40.
