## Employment Law Watch

### *Proposed Holiday Increase*

The Government has now published its response to the second consultation on proposals to increase statutory holiday to 28 days, which closed on 13 April 2007.

It was initially proposed that the increase would be introduced in 2 stages, with entitlement increasing to 24 days on 1 October 2007, and to 28 days on 1 October 2008. However, the Government in its response has decided to delay implementation of the second increase from 1 October 2008 to 1 April 2009.
